

Reading at Crosby Ravensworth School

At Crosby Ravensworth Primary School it is our aim that by the end of their primary education, all pupils are able to read and write fluently with confidence, understanding and passion. We prioritise the teaching of reading and writing and we aim to develop life-long, positive attitudes for all of our pupils.



At Crosby Ravensworth School we use the phonics scheme 'Rocket Phonics' in Reception and Key Stage One. Although phonics is not taught in Key Stage Two, children in class 2 will be supported in their reading and spelling using Rocket Phonics. We have invested heavily in this scheme to ensure pupils learn all the skills needed to successfully read, write and spell.





Reading With Your Child

Guided Reading with your child, using books matched to the phonics sounds of the week, takes place in school at least twice a week.



Did you know?

Children who read outside of school every day are five times as likely to read above the expected level compared with those who don't.

Let's get reading!

Your child will bring home a Rocket Phonics Reader book to read each night. These books are fully aligned to the programme and are matched to your child's phonics decoding level requiring minimal parental support. Please listen to your child read these books at least 4 times a week and write a comment in their reading record.

A school library book chosen by your child will also be brought home. These are intended for you to share with their child as many of the sounds may not yet have been covered in class.
