## Food Waste

This week we have been finding out about food waste. 50% of most school's waste in the UK is food waste. The children are measuring our food waste at lunchtime and finding ways to reduce this. We also found out that up to 30% of produce is thrown out from farms. Vista Veg is a local cooperative vegetable business that is supplied by small producers. Any wasted produce is composted. Their delivery van is also run on bio-diesel produced from used oil from local businesses. If you are interested in reducing your carbon footprint by buying a vegetable box from them, a leaflet is included in this Friday bulletin.
