Friends AGM

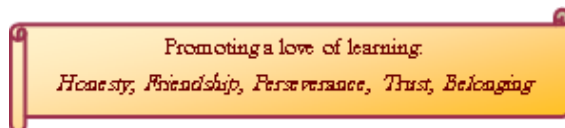

The Old Woman and the Red Pumpkin

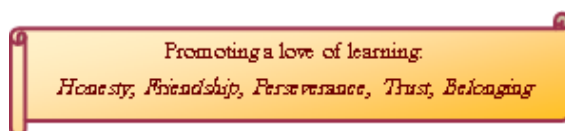
