Dear Parents

Attendance affected by COVID 19

I have had a few questions about attendance in relation to Covid and feel the following information from Public Health Cumbria will be of interest:

- Children don't need to isolate unless: symptomatic with COVID symptoms, if they have tested positive themselves, if they are following quarantining advice, or if they have been advised to isolate for any other reason.
They no longer need to isolate if they are identified as a close contact of a positive case.
- There will be potentially different scenarios whereby a parent may choose to keep their child off e.g.,
 - All adults in the house have tested positive and have a legal duty to isolate – they cannot arrange for someone else to get the child to school and don't want to leave the house themselves. It would be unfair in this instance to record an unauthorised absence.
 - The parents are acting 'on the safe side' and want to keep the child at home until they have spoken to NHSTT and been advised that the child doesn't need to isolate but should get a PCR test.
Schools are asked to advise parents to arrange a PCR test for the child but offer reassurance that the child can attend school whilst waiting for the test and the result, so schools may record this as an unauthorised absence.
 - The parents have made the decision to keep the child off for the full 10 days.
This decision sits outside the national guidance and would usually be recorded as an unauthorised absence.

Morland Area Netball and Football Tournament

Thirteen of the children in Class 2 will be taking part in the Morland tournament next Thursday 16th which starts at 3.30pm and 5.30pm. All those taking part have been informed via an additional letter sent with this bulletin. Any children who would like to go along and support their classmates would be most welcome. Refreshments will be available to buy.
