100% have access to internet at home
55% access the internet in their own room
22% claim there are no privacy controls set up on their device
All children said that they only sometimes/rarely/never speak to adults at home about safety rules when online
95% understand that personal information should not be shared online
77% said they have seen something online that has made them feel uncomfortable
5 children said they DID NOT know what to do if they saw something online that made them feel uncomfortable. (Surprising as Mrs P talks about this very regularly in assemblies.

Mrs Pattinson will follow up issues raised by this questionnaire with the children after half term.
