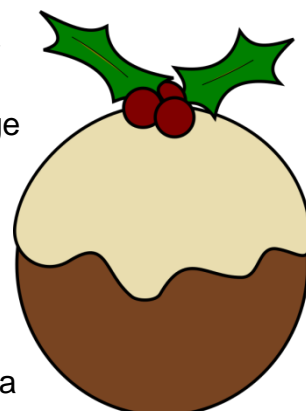
Dear Parents,

Lacrosse Competition

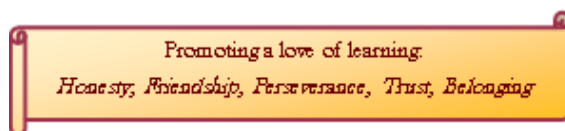

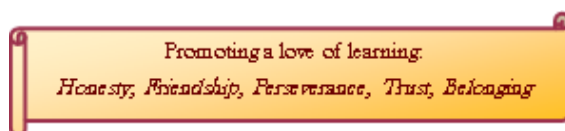

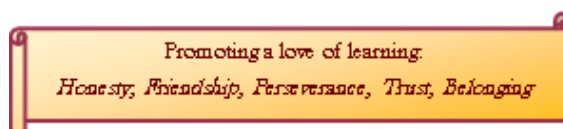
