It has come to our attention that there will be a road closure in Maulds Meaburn from the 4th March. Please see enclosed map in your child's wallet:


These works are expected to commence on 4th March 2019 with an approx. duration of 3 days.

Last Sunday was a sell out. All cakes and bakes gone by 3pm!




