Y6 Leavers Service' - Carlisle

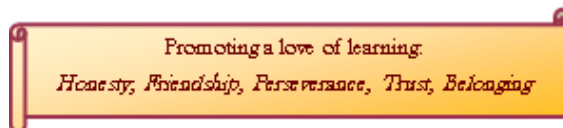

Together with your child, please can you select the most appropriate walk for his/her abilities from those outlined above, then complete and return the reply slip attached to this bulletin.

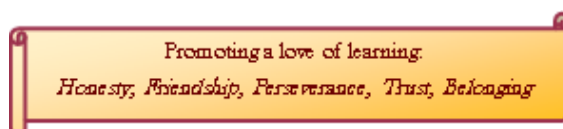

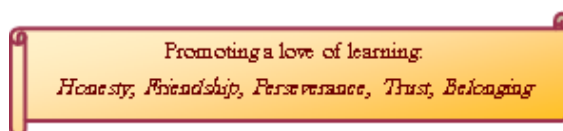

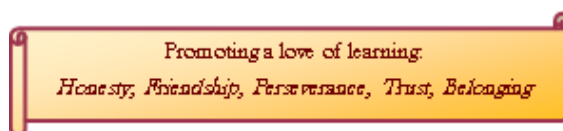
