Reminder - The last day for pre entries for Appleby Fun Run is Friday 16th June.

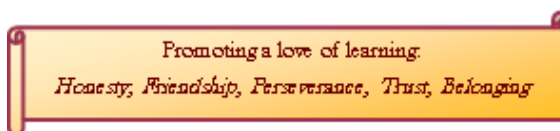
Message from Sarah Rogers

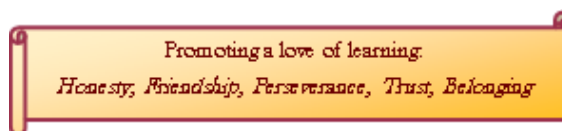

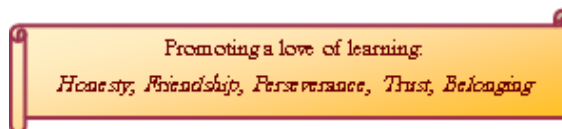

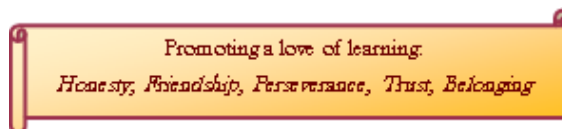
