Attendance

Having written to every parent individually regarding children's attendance before half term, I'd like to offer an update on the situation. Since that point, when school attendance for the term was 89%, this has now risen to 93%.

Attendance was discussed at the school governors' meeting last week: I've been asked to pass on their appreciation of the very genuine difficulties that many families have faced this year. By way of encouragement, the school is now re-launching its reward system for good attendance. All pupils exceeding 99% attendance for a term will receive a special certificate. There will be a special prize for any pupil who is able to maintain 99% or above for the year to commemorate their remarkable achievement.


