Wrap-around Care

Thank you again for your continued support of after school club, which continues to prosper. We are confident of offering a long-standing commitment to wrap-around care that is financially viable and that the parents can come to rely upon to support their working lives.

School has decided to roll-over its existing discount system across siblings so that it helps support families with more than one child.

Buy 4 sessions in any week, get the fifth session free.

Hence, a family with 3 children can now receive 10 sessions for the price of 8; 15 sessions for the price of 12 etc.

Parents wishing to use the 8am Breakfast Club are reminded to book in advance. This enables school to plan accordingly and reduce unnecessary staffing costs. When using the 8.30am 50p drop-off service, parents **must** make face-to-face contact with a member of staff to ensure their child can be safely supervised before leaving them.

I'd like to thank Glen, Neil and Alister for supporting the school with an excellent bike-club this half term. Such voluntary help makes a big difference to our capacity to maintain quality after-school experiences for the children. We'd be very grateful if other parents could help us run clubs in future. A list of activities for the Summer term is currently being put together – please see Mrs Corrie or myself if you feel you might be able to help.
