Orienteering – Y5 & Y6

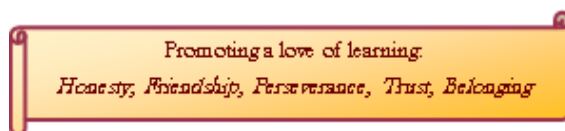

Friday -	Taekwondo	An amazing opportunity for a new challenge! Book early to avoid disappointment

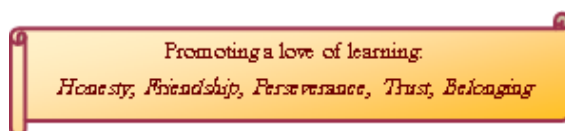
Message from Sarah Rogers

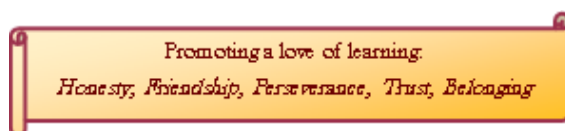
