Dear Parents

As you will be aware we are now seeing a rapid rise in COVID-19 infections in the county. As of Thursday, 47 educational settings are in incident (one confirmed case) or outbreak (two or more confirmed cases) status. In light of this, we continue to closely follow council guidance which includes restrictions regarding end of key stage transition, end of year events and day trips. We have been told to be cautious, risk assess carefully and make alternative arrangements if activities cannot be conducted safely. Parents should read the <u>general advice letter</u> and <u>'COVID-19 Quick</u> <u>Guide'</u> which has been produced by Director of Public Health, Colin Cox.

I'm sorry to say this means that our plans to take the children to Manchester Chill Factore have had to be scrapped. The class 1 trip to Leighton Moss will still take place, but parents must be aware that regulations require that in the event of their child showing symptoms of COVID during the day, they would have to pick up their child **from the venue** immediately. We hope these would be rare circumstances, but if you know this to be a particular problem, you should contact the school office for further advice.

As it stands, Sports Day will go ahead as usual, and while parents will still be welcome to attend, we are obliged to restrict the number of visitors to no more than 30 people. A maximum of two people per household can apply by email to Pauline to attend Sports Day and tickets will be issued on a first come first served basis. Please don't apply for two tickets unless you know you will use them.
