Silent Auction

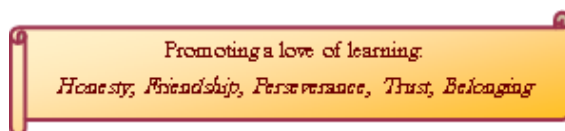
HURRY! There's not much time left!!!

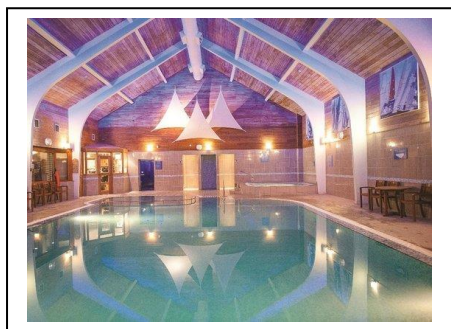

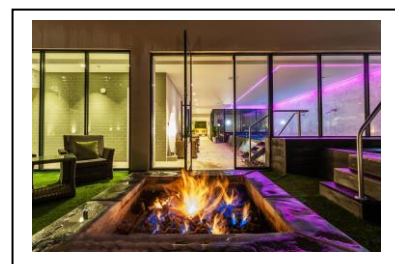

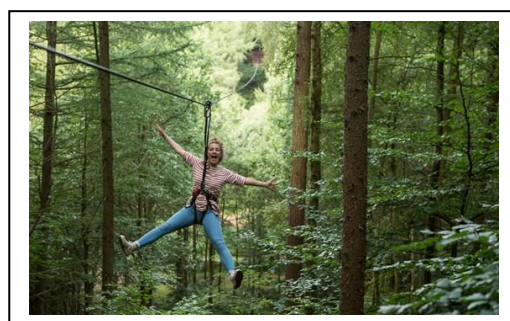

St Bee's Trip Monday 21st May

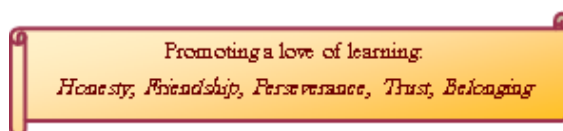

Spellings – Practise makes Perfect!!

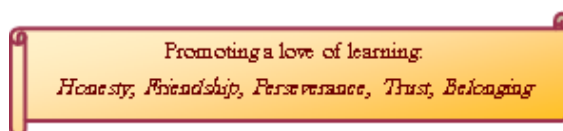
KS2 children have been practising spellings on www.spellingframe.co.uk. It would really benefit them if they could do further practise at home, especially over the long summer holidays. Thanks

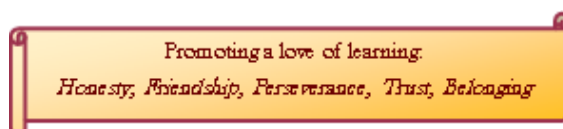

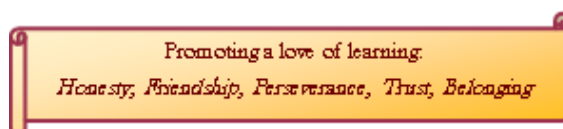
