Easter Service

There will be an Easter service in church (no congregation sadly) at 2pm on 30th March. Please read the following message from Rev Stewart Fyfe:

"Our Easter service will take place in St Lawrence's Church on Tuesday 30 March. Ordinarily, parents and governors would be invited to this, but sadly that is not possible this year. As a church school we have a tradition of offering "the 3 C's - Christening, Communion and Confirmation" through school. Easter is the most important Christian festival, and the centrepiece of Christian Easter worship is to share Holy Communion in celebration of the resurrection of Jesus. Due to lockdown it is a while since we had a whole school Communion service, but we will be celebrating Holy Communion as part of our Easter service.

Children who have been admitted to Holy Communion, either through school or previously in their local church, are invited to receive Communion (bread form only). Children who have not been admitted will still participate in the worship and we are sure they will benefit from first-hand experience of this important act of worship for Christians. As Rector, I hold a record of those admitted to Communion. If your child has been admitted to receive communion through your local church (of any denomination) and we are not aware of it, please e-mail me (rectornwparishes@gmail.com) if you wish your child to receive Communion in school. We will be offering a fresh opportunity for Children to be prepared, through school, for admission to Communion or Confirmation next term. More information will be provided at that time."
