Attendance in School

Attendance in school has dropped considerably this term compared to our usually high figures. While COVID related issues have had an impact, our data has drawn the eye of the local authority as Cumbria's target for attendance is 96% but Crosby currently runs at 92%. We have been reminded that colds and coughs are common at this time of year but it is expected that children continue to attend unless symptoms are particularly severe. It is expected that any persistent medical absence is supported by medical evidence, which parents are duty-bound to secure. Going to school regularly is important for each child's future. Parents are legally responsible for making sure their children receive full-time education and could be fined or prosecuted as part of the local authority's process.

The school has a clear policy regarding holidays in term time <u>which can be read here</u>. Holidays are only authorized in exceptional circumstances. To read more about the impact that absence from school has on pupils, I would encourage parents to <u>read this article</u>.

Personal circumstances change all the time and many have felt hardship throughout this pandemic.
