School Play

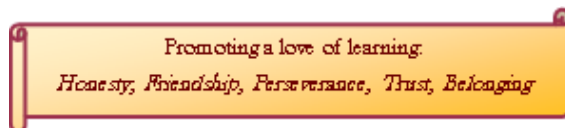

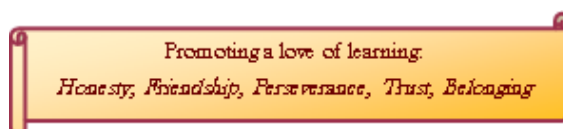

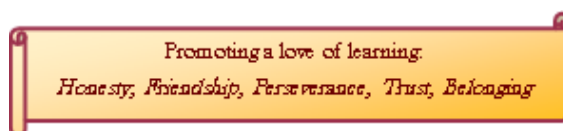
