Class 1 Peter Rabbit Event

On Wednesday 6th July, Class 1 will be visiting Appleby Castle to watch a special performance of a play based on the Peter Rabbit story. The children will be taking a packed lunch with them and are hoping to enjoy a picnic in the castle grounds if the weather allows. If your child normally has school lunches but would prefer to bring a packed lunch from home, please let the office know.

Class 2 Recorder practise

Carolyn has recorded short tuitional videos for each of the children in Class 2 to use when practising their recorder pieces. These videos have been forwarded by email to the parents of each child this morning. I'd be grateful if you'd encourage your children to practise a little each day to help them progress quickly as we're intending they perform at the end of year church service on Thursday 14th July.

School Sponsored Walk

The sponsored walk has been postponed by a week to Monday 11th July when it will hopefully be drier underfoot. As usual, the walks will fit into the timings of a normal school day.

We are planning two walks this year:

- Class 1: 3 miles (with an opt out for younger children on the day if necessary)
This will start after Pop-in and Play at 10.30am
- Class 2: approx 10 miles

Your child will need:

- Appropriate clothing for the walk and the weather. This includes appropriate footwear – preferably walking boots or water-resistant trainers, NOT wellies for the long walk.
- Long trousers on the long walk to protect against nettles
- Suncream applied prior to leaving home

All children will need a rucksack containing the following:

- a bottle of water
- healthy snacks
- a waterproof coat
- a sunhat
- inhalers if required

The children will also all be carrying their packed lunch, provided by school or home. If your child has a school meal a packed lunch will be provided by Freda. If you wish your child to provide their own, please notify the office. We ask that children do not carry unnecessary items to ensure that their rucksacks are as light as possible. Do feel free to approach school with any concerns or queries you may have.


Summer Fair

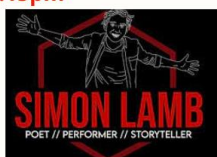
