Car Seats

Regarding child car seats government guidelines state that: A backless booster seat should only be used by children who are taller than 125 cm and weigh more than 22kg. High back booster seats can be used by children who weigh between 15-36kg. Older backless booster seats manufactured before March 2017 can still be legally used by a child weighing 15-36kg but this is not recommended by child seat experts.

Please weigh and measure your child. We have plenty of pre-2017 booster seats in school. In future for trips if you would like your child to use a high-back booster seat instead of our booster seats please can you provide your own.
