Lakeside activities at Windermere

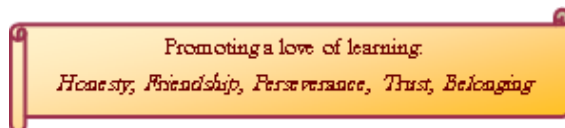

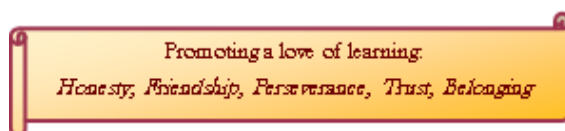
