COVID Update

You will find with today's bulletin a letter to parents and carers from Director of Public Health Cumbria, Colin Cox. [It can also be read here](#). It advises that children and young people aged between the ages of 5 and 16, (unless exempt) should now stay at home when a sibling tests positive for COVID-19 (via either a PCR or Lateral Flow test). This is a strengthening of public health measures designed to reduce the current surge in cases among young people in the county. Please continue to follow our covid measures in school: children should sanitize their hands on entry, parents and families should stay off the premises unless by prior invitation. All staff are continuing to take lateral flow tests twice weekly.
