Dear Parents

On Monday 21 February the Prime Minister set out the next phase of the government's COVID-19 response '[Living with COVID-19](#)'. The government has removed the legal requirement to isolate following a positive test. We've been told to expect a letter to share with parents from Cumbria Public Health which will set out the position of the county on this. Until that point, schools in our cluster are continuing to ask families to respect the 5-day rule for isolation of positive cases and to check with daily lateral flow tests for close contacts. Thank you for your cooperation.

### Planetarium

On the afternoon of the 2<sup>nd</sup> of March, the whole school will be visiting Maulds Meaburn Village Hall to attend the temporary planetarium between 2pm-3pm.
