Dear Parents

This has been a particularly challenging week for schools in Cumbria, with around 55 dealing with isolated cases of covid among staff or pupils and 10 dealing with larger outbreaks and two schools closed. The [latest data published today](#) from the county's Public Health team shows covid cases almost doubling again in the last week, just as they have in the previous two weeks, so we are in a worsening position. The local authority's advice has reverted back to what it was months ago in terms of wearing masks, visitors to schools and so on. Unfortunately it simply reflects the position we're in. We've been asked to ensure that parents are aware of the [Covid quick guide](#) produced by the Public Health team.
