Cumbria Music Service are organising lots of music and arts events over the coming months. Fun for all the Family! Please see the attached leaflet.

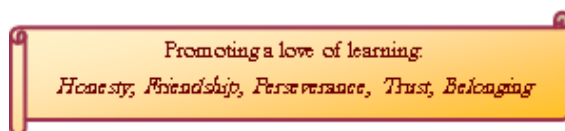
### Sponsored Walk 2018 Change of Date

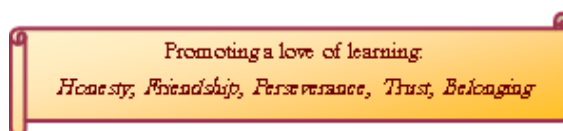

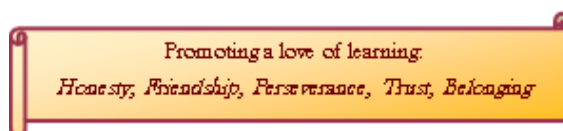
