Class 1 Summer Reading Challenge

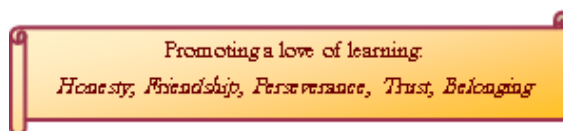

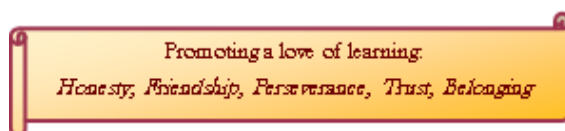
