# Attendance in school

National attendance in primary schools last year was 96.1%: I'm alarmed to see exactly 50% of our pupils are not reaching this figure at present. Attendance in school increases academic performance, which in turn enhances future life opportunities. When children are absent, the sequence of learning is broken which impacts on the rest of the topic. Absence also has a negative effect on the rest of the class as time is given to help with catch-up. If your child has a fever, they should stay at home until better, and after vomiting or diarrhoea, they should stay at home for at least 48 hours after the last episode. But in all other cases, if you are not sure if your child is well enough to attend school, please send them in and we will monitor them carefully and be sure to contact you if they need to go home. Resilience is an important life skill which we strive to develop in our children.
