Dear Parents

Christmas is fast approaching and one of our favourite events is the Christmas Community Lunch where parents and members of the community are invited to join us for a festive Christmas dinner with the children. At the time of writing, plans are being made to hold it in the village hall this year which will enable us to spread people out and reduce the risks of COVID infection. Please be aware that ALL of our Christmas plans could be subject to change at very short notice if the situation dictates. Lunch should commence at 12pm on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December and will be followed by a Christmas party for the children – please complete the reply slip attached to this bulletin for tickets. We are limiting capacity.

Keeping to our school Christmas traditions, the children will be making Christmas Crackers for the Community Lunch and what's a good cracker without a terrible joke? We are therefore asking that the children bring into school at least two jokes to be used in this year's crackers. You may know some great ones, or perhaps the children would like to make up their own. We'd like the jokes to be brought in and given to class teachers on Monday so we can start the week with a good chuckle.

### School Christmas Play

It is the talk of the Eden primary school cluster: is your school play going ahead this year? The consensus is very much 'yes', however vigilance is the key and the following should be noted:

- We may have to cancel at the last minute - if we do we will video a performance for sharing.
- Audience numbers will be limited to 65. This means 3 tickets per household maximum although plans may be adapted for an additional matinee performance if required.
- People should not attend if they have any symptoms.
- We recommend face coverings & lateral flow tests are taken. This of course is optional.
- There will be **NO** bring and share after the school play this year.
- All windows and doors will be open throughout. Please wrap up warm!!
- Entry and exit doors will be clearly marked to secure a one-way travel system.
- Track and trace details will be taken on entry.

Parents collect their children as soon as possible after the end of the play. The performance starts at 6pm. Children should arrive at 5.45pm, at which time the doors will also open to the public to be seated. Donations will be taken at the door where programmes will be given out.

### Christmas Carol Service

The Christmas Carol Service will be taking place in church at 6pm on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December. This will be a particularly special occasion for children, parents and friends as it will be our last chance to bid farewell to Stewart before moving to pastures new. We hope to see as many of you as possible.
