Slack Randy MTB Challenge – 24th June

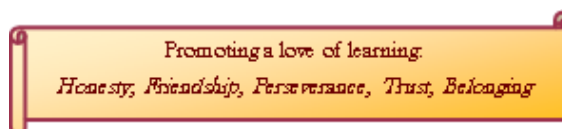

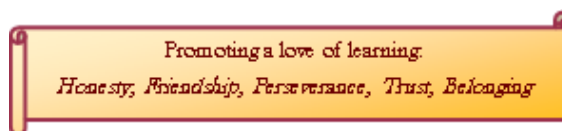

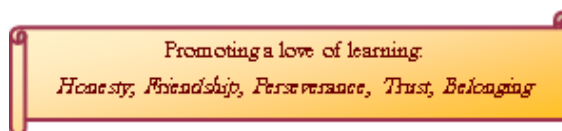
