Video clinics are available for parents and carers across the whole of Cumbria every Monday afternoon and all day Tuesday and Thursdays. Instead of being face to face, you will talk to the nurse over a live video link that is private and secure. The nurse, in consultation with you, will assess the child's health problems and provide you with support and advice. 






Clerk vacancy
