Sports Hall Athletics

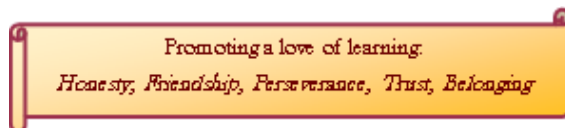

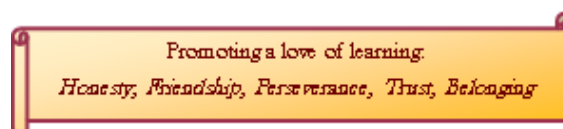

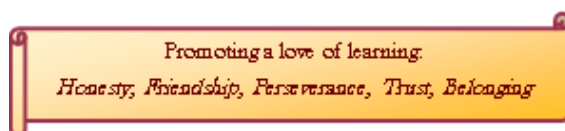
