#### **Message from Sarah Rogers:**

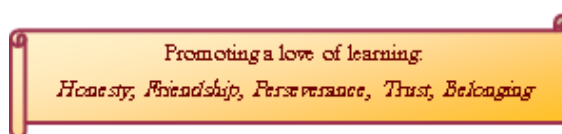
*Open Gardens – Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July*

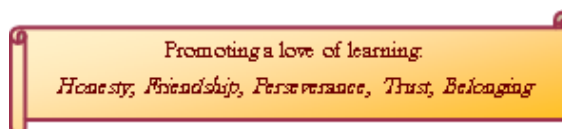

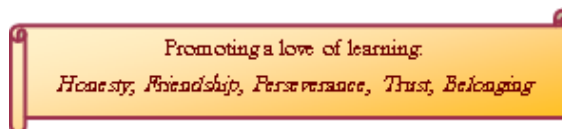
