Sponsored Walk

We are fast approaching our sponsored walk event and have planned for the children to do the following walks:

- inhalers if required
- packed lunch which will be provided by school or home

Children on walk A will eat their lunch at school after the walk has finished and will not need to carry it with them. On walks B and C children will be carrying their packed lunch. We ask that children do not carry unnecessary items to ensure that their rucksacks are as light as possible. We are hoping we will be blessed with beautiful weather on the day and that it will be a great success for all. Please approach school with any queries you may have.
