Please note that as usual, we will break up on the last day of each term at 2pm without afterschool club arrangements.

# School trip – Westmorland Show

All school-age children (Reception up to Year 6) will be taken to Westmorland Show in Kendal next Wednesday, 8<sup>th</sup> September. This will be a full day so parents of reception-aged children may wish to discuss any concerns with Mrs Corrie. The trip will support the class 2 topic of 'sustainable food' and the class 1 topic of 'transport'. We look forward to continuing our understanding and celebration of farming in Cumbria. Children should arrive in school jumper with appropriate footwear for the conditions and bring a small rucksack with a bottle of water and a waterproof coat. Children should arrive in school at the usual time and will return in time for normal collection.
