The categories are Nursery / Primary age children and over 11 years / Adults (20p per entry for over 11's)

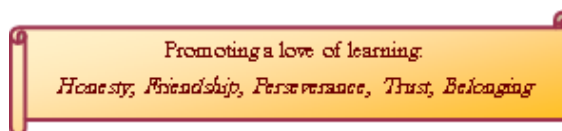

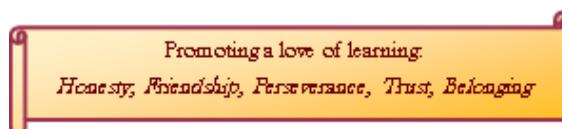

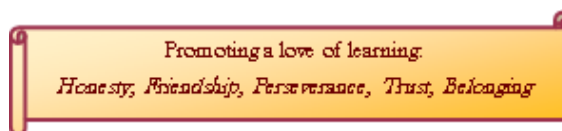
