Can I also urge families, to come along and support the Open Gardens as there will be a picture quiz for the children to complete as they look around the gardens.

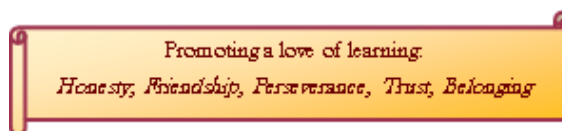
Every completed correct entry will go into a draw, the winner of which will get tickets to go to Lowther Castle and the newly extended Lost Castle playground.

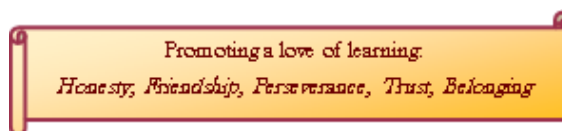

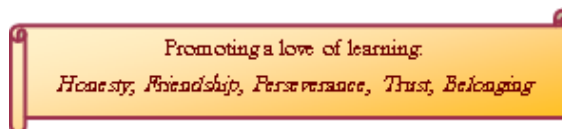
