### Cycle Helmets

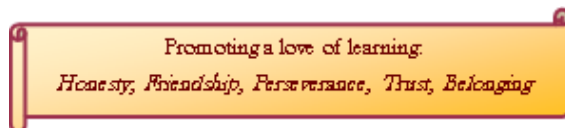

### **Mothers' Day Craft Fair**

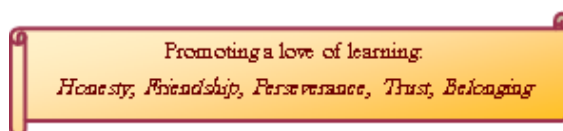

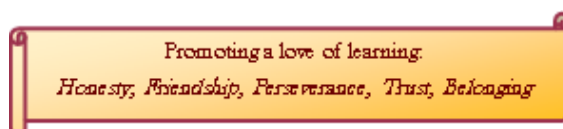
