Dear Parents

Applying for summer term places at Crosby Preschool.

All new-starter applications from parents wishing for their child to commence the summer term 2023 at Crosby Preschool must be received in writing by Monday 6th March at the very latest which represents six weeks before the commencement of term on Monday 17th April. Sessions will run on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays as per the attached form.

The form must also be used to identify wrap-around care needs for the term ahead; 30-hour childcare vouchers may be used as full or part payment. Please note that wrap-around care will not be available for preschool on an ad-hoc basis unless in exceptional circumstances.

Governors are restricting the maximum number of preschool places at any session to 10 pupils. Parents should be aware that places for summer term are in high demand and all applications received by those within our catchment will be treated on a first come first served basis.

World Book Day celebrations at Crosby

We have a number of special events lined up to celebrate World Book Day. On Thursday 2nd, children will be invited to come dressed up as a character from a book of their choice. There will be extra house-points for children who bring in a copy of the book which features the character. We're prepared to offer double the points for any parents who drop their children dressed as a book day character!!
