Class 2 Talking homework discussion topic

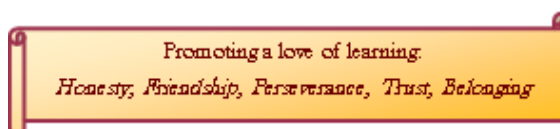

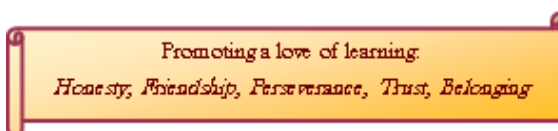
Wednesday – Back by public demand, Wizz's outdoor circuits. Test your fitness levels and have fun!

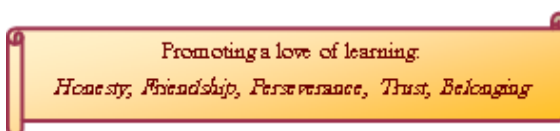
