Maths and Science day – Year 5

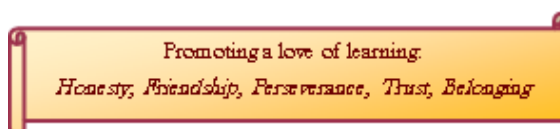

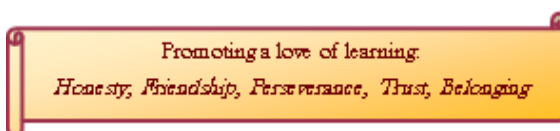

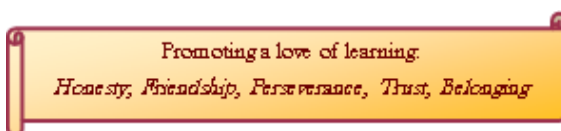
