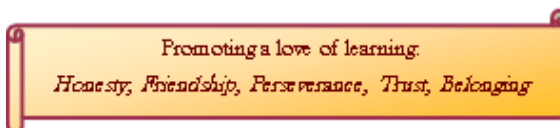
We will be holding a props making session straight after school on Tuesday 3rd December. Any help will be gratefully received!

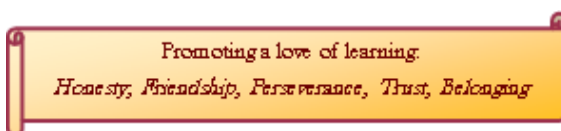

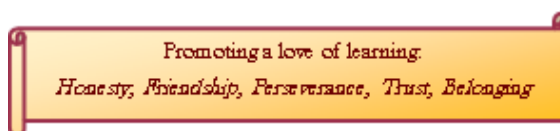

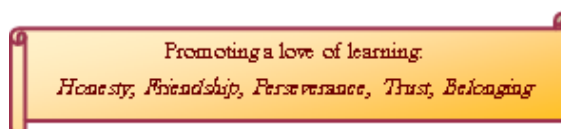
