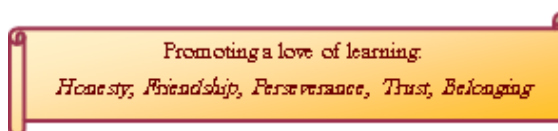
Today in your plastic wallet there is an e-safety document for pupils in KS1 and KS2. Please read, sign and return to the school office. Thank you.

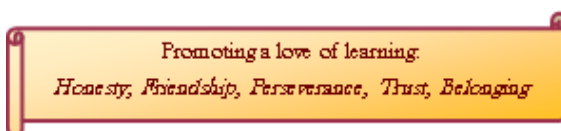

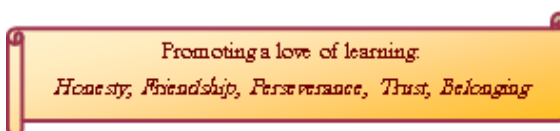
