Milk – KS1

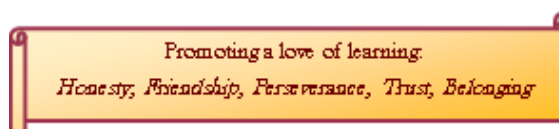

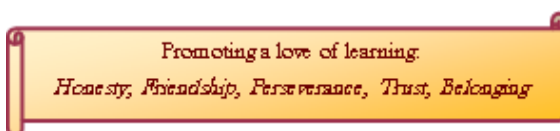
