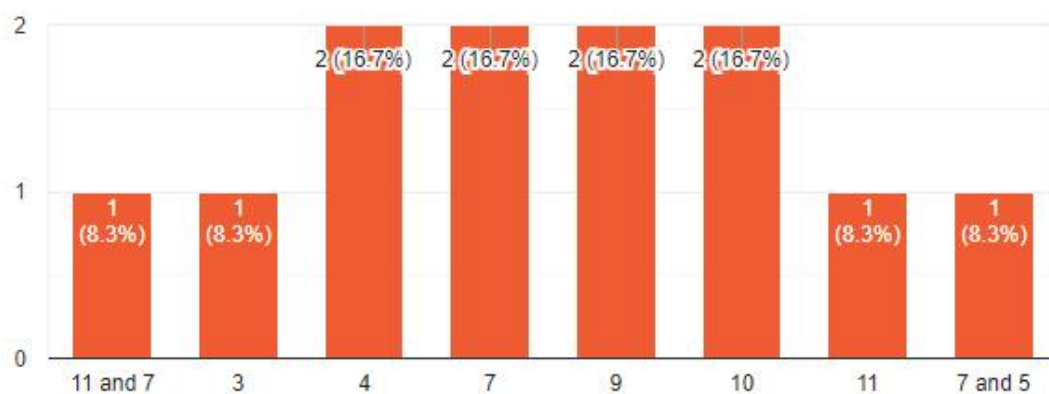

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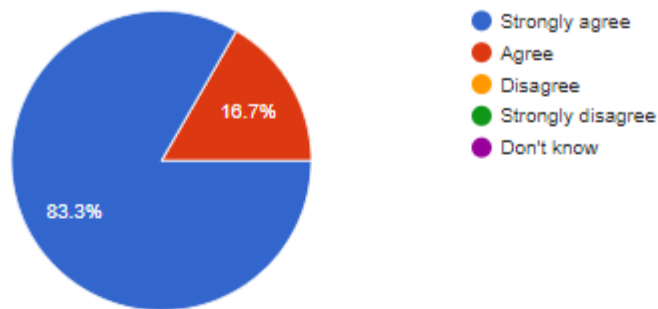

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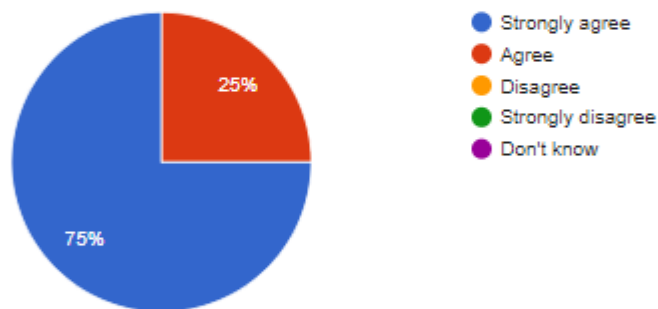

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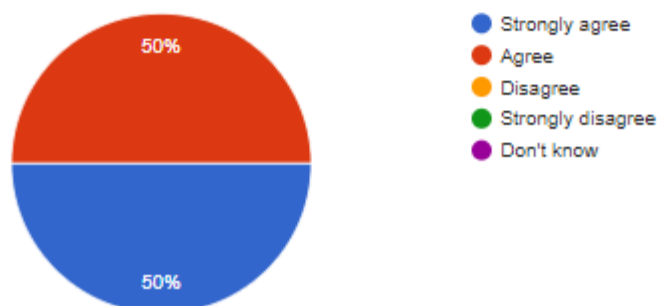

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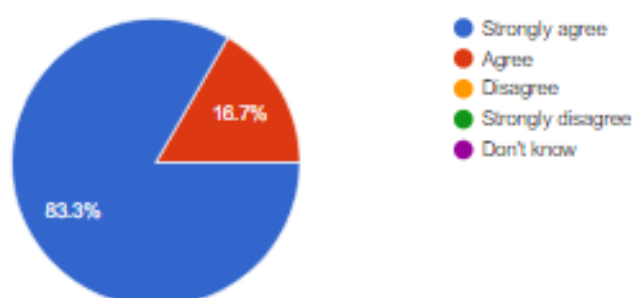

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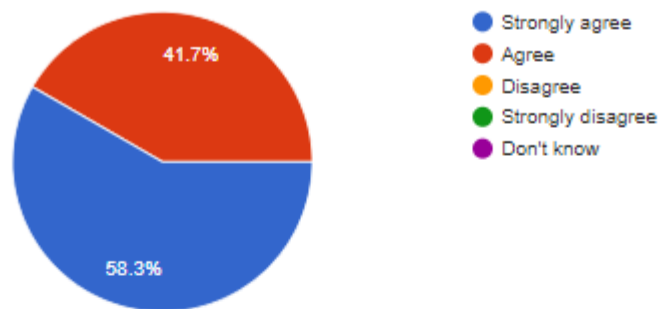

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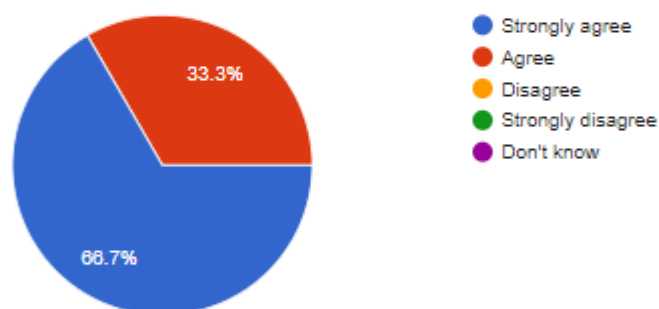

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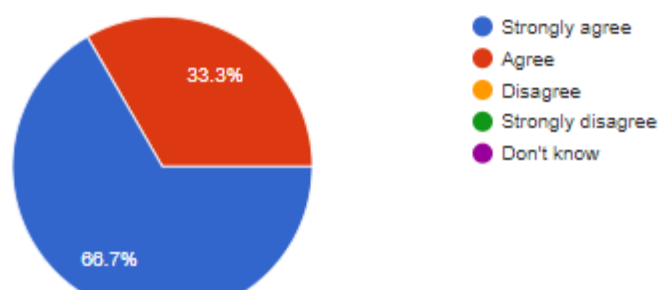

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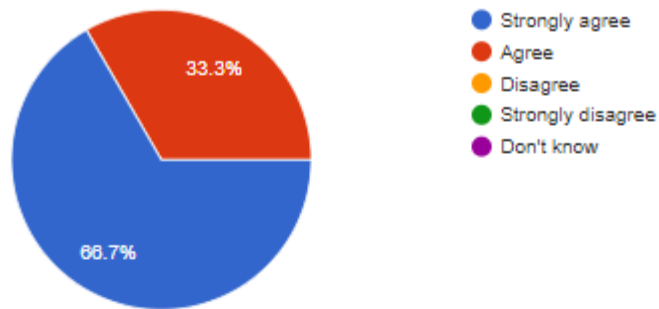

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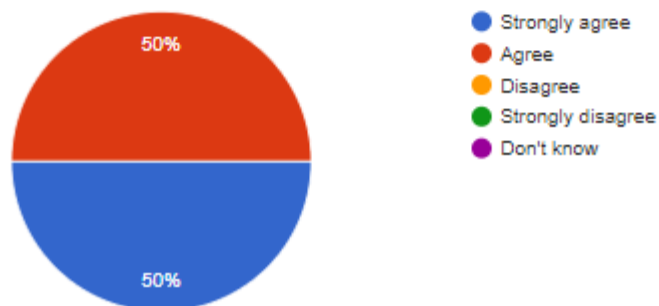

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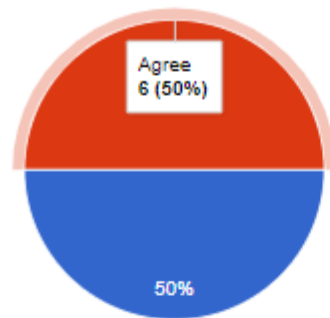

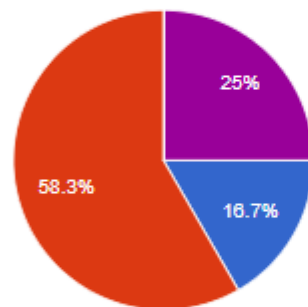

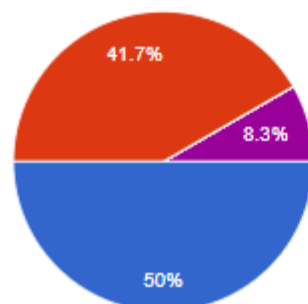

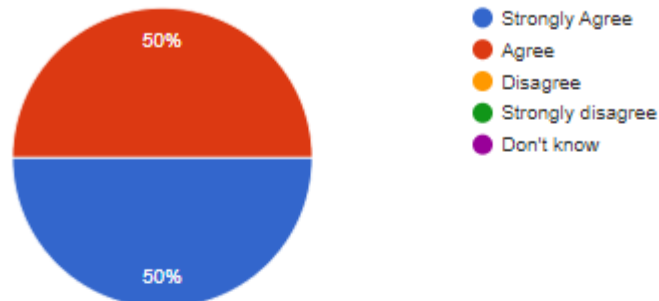

15. There is a good range of activities that my child finds interesting and enjoyable.

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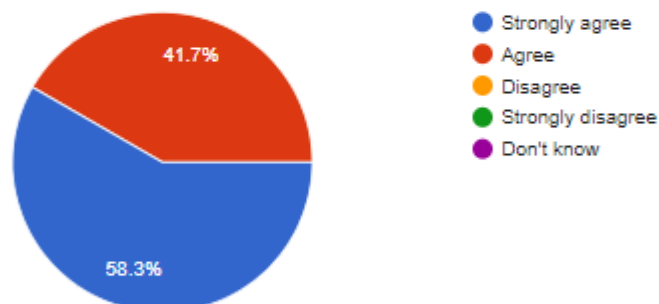

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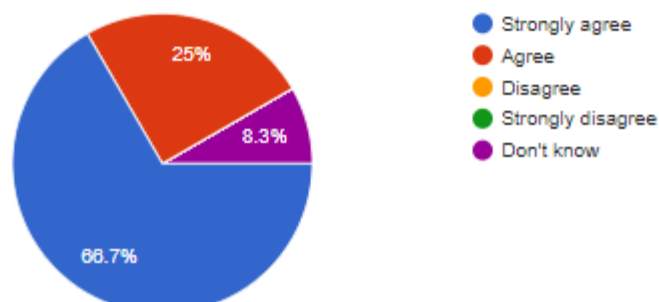

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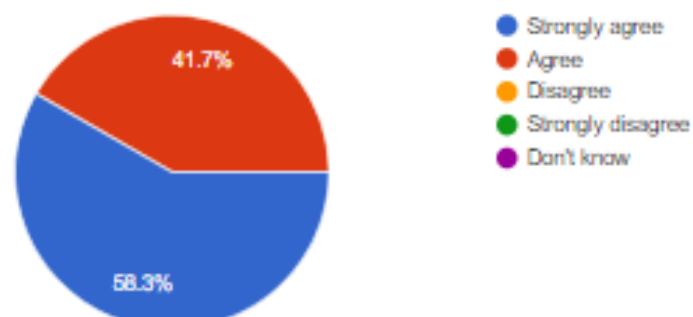

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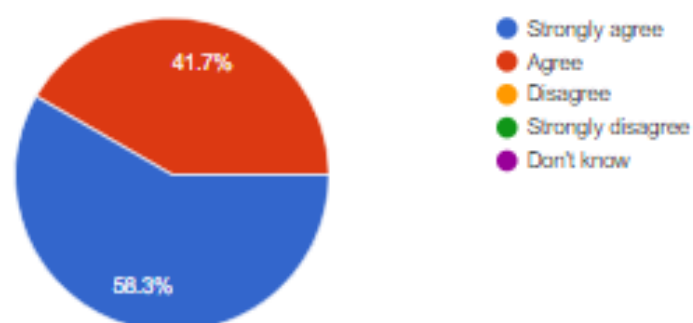

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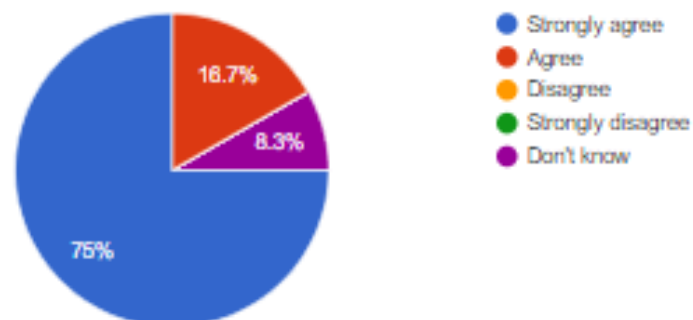
